### Population<sup>1</sup>

The 2015 population for Angus is 116,900; an increase of 0.1 per cent from 116,740 in 2014. The population of Angus accounts for 2.2 per cent of the total population of Scotland.

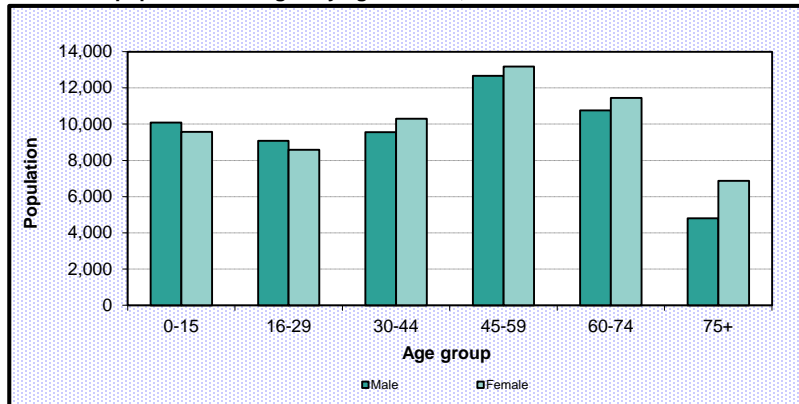
In Angus, 15.1 per cent of the population are aged 16 to 29 years. This is smaller than Scotland where 18.2 per cent are aged 16 to 29 years. Persons aged 60 and over make up 29.0 per cent of Angus. This is larger than Scotland where 24.2 per cent are aged 60 and over.

Since 1989, Angus's total population has risen overall. Scotland's population has also risen over this period.

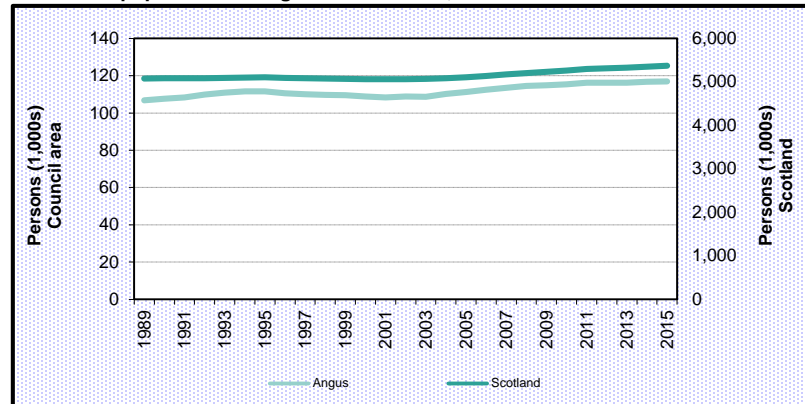

## Births<sup>2</sup> (calendar year)

Between 2014 and 2015 Angus experienced a 7.1 per cent decrease in the number of births, dropping from 1,146 in 2014, to 1,065 in 2015. The number of births in Scotland fell by 2.9 per cent.

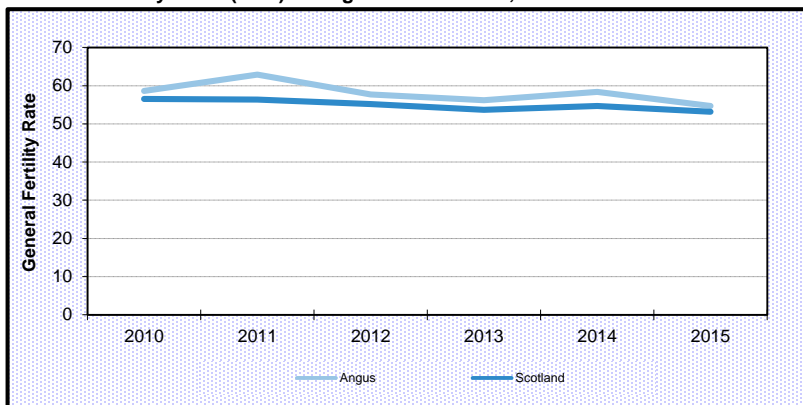
The most popular name given to boys born in Angus in 2015 was James and the most popular name given to girls was Sophie.

Fertility in Angus decreased from 58.4 births per 1,000 women aged 15 to 44 in 2014, to 54.7 in 2015. For Scotland as a whole, the general fertility rate decreased from 54.7 births per 1,000 women aged 15 to 44 in 2014, to 53.2 in 2015.

### General Fertility Rate\* (GFR) in Angus and Scotland, 2010-2015

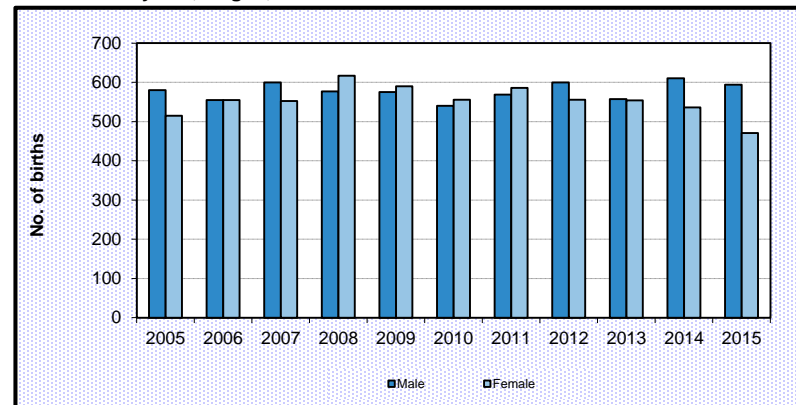

### Live births by sex, Angus, 2005-2015



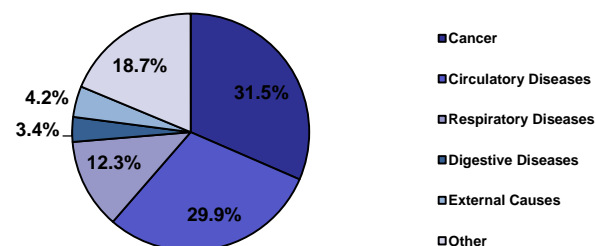
## Deaths<sup>3</sup> (calendar year)

The number of deaths in Angus increased from 1,306 in 2014 to 1,347 in 2015. Over the period 2013 to 2015 the overall death rate was lower for males than for females. Compared to Scotland over the period 2013 to 2015, Angus had a higher death rate. The main cause of death in Angus was circulatory disease, followed by cancer.

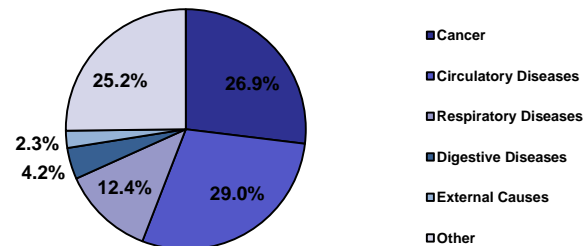

## Migration<sup>4</sup>

On average in 2013-15 there was a net inflow of 433 people into Angus per year, meaning that more people entered Angus (4,162 per year) than left (3,729 per year). The 16 to 29 year olds age group accounted for the largest group of in-migrants into Angus. The largest group of out-migrants was also the 16 to 29 year olds.

## Life Expectancy

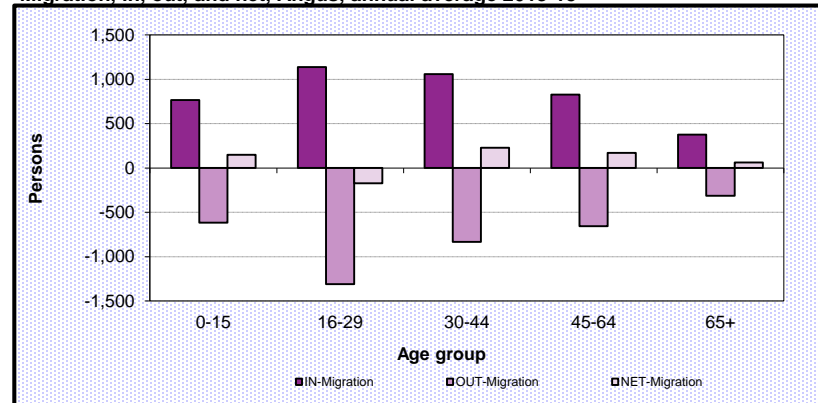
Female life expectancy at birth (81.8 years) is greater than male life expectancy (78.6 years), and both were greater than the Scottish average. Male life expectancy at birth in Angus is improving more rapidly than female life expectancy.

In Angus female life expectancy at age 65 (20.3 years) is greater than male life expectancy at age 65 (18.1 years).

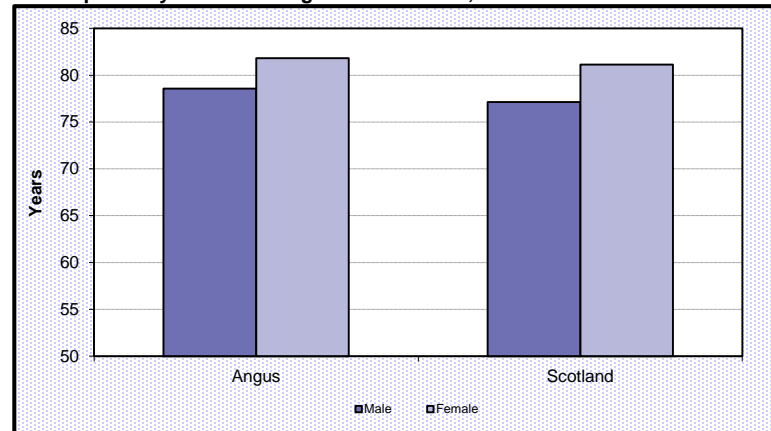

## Marriages & Civil Partnerships

There were 506 marriages in Angus in 2015; an increase of 9.5 per cent from 2014.

In Angus 48.5 per cent of people marrying in 2015 were aged 25-34. In Scotland as a whole 47.5 per cent of people marrying were in this age group.

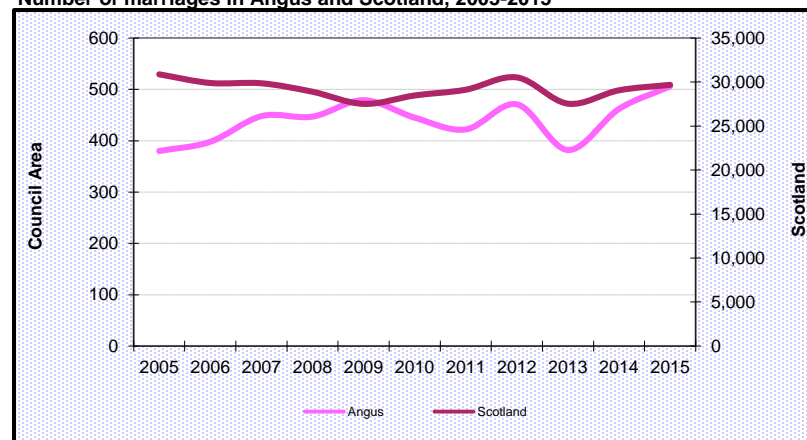
Since 2005 the number of marriages in Angus has risen by 33.2 per cent.

## Population Projections

By 2039 the population of Angus is projected to be 120,799, an increase of 3.5 per cent compared to the population in 2014. The population of Scotland is projected to increase by 7.5 per cent between 2014 and 2039.

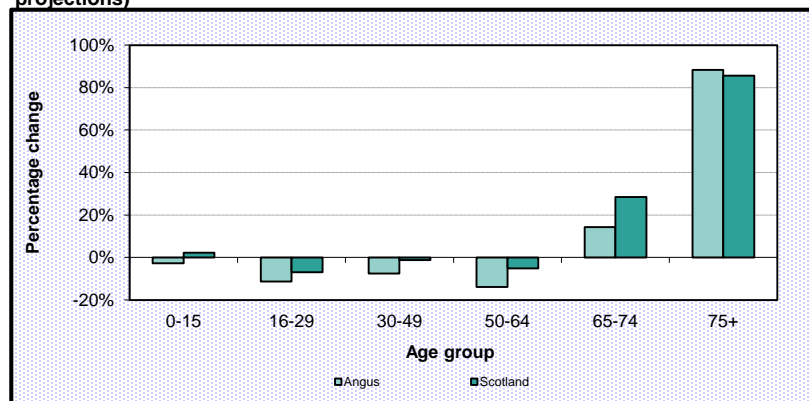
Over the 25 year period, the age group that is projected to increase the most in size in Angus is the 75+ age group. This is the same as for Scotland as a whole.

The population aged under 16 in Angus is projected to decline by 2.7 per cent over the 25 year period.

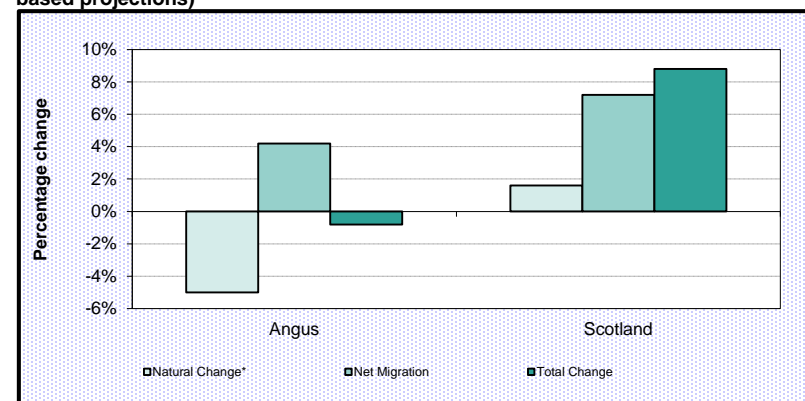

## Households & Dwellings

The 2015 estimate of the number of households in Angus is 53,142. This is a 0.9 per cent increase in the 2014 figure of 52,692, compared to a 0.6 per cent increase in Scotland as a whole. The proportion of these households receiving a single adult Council Tax discount is 36.4 per cent. For Scotland, this figure is 37.4 per cent.

With regards to the dwellings in Angus, 95 per cent are occupied, 4 per cent are vacant and 1 per cent are second homes. The proportions of dwellings in Scotland which are vacant and second homes are 3.1 per cent and 1.1 per cent, respectively.

The 2015 estimate of the number of dwellings in Angus is 55,619. This is an increase of 0.6 per cent from 2014 and compares to a 0.7 per cent increase across Scotland as a whole.

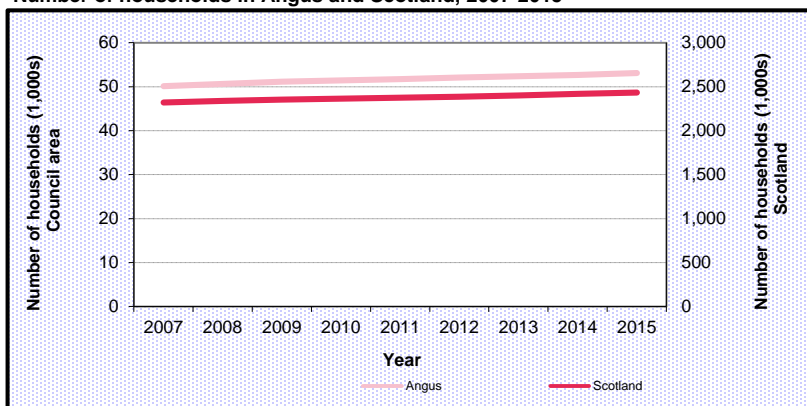

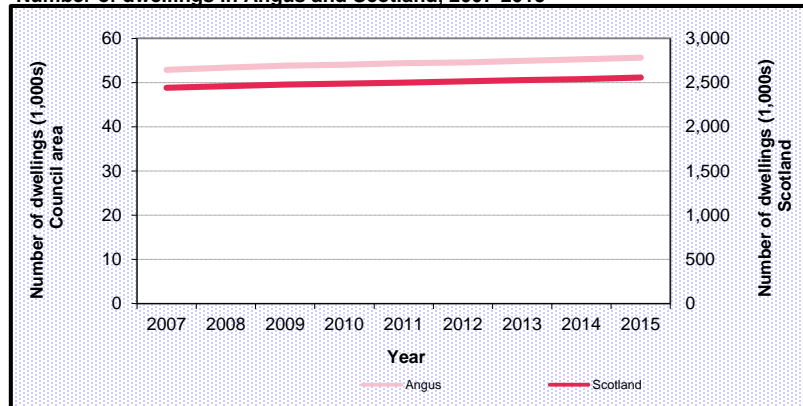

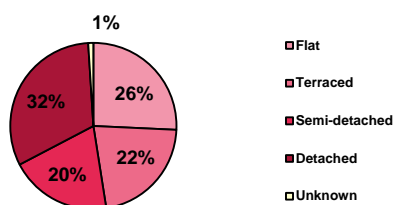
### Number of households in Angus and Scotland, 2007-2015



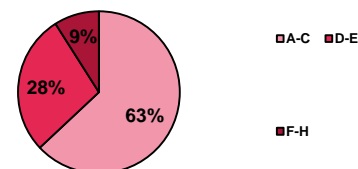
### Number of dwellings in Angus and Scotland, 2007-2015

### Proportions of dwellings by Council Tax band in Angus, 2015



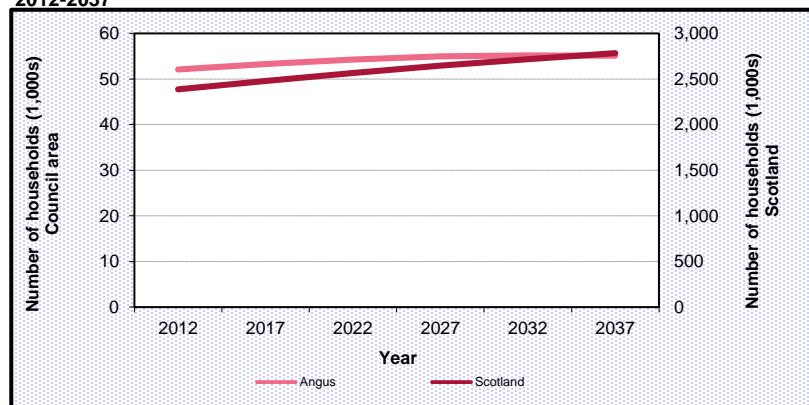
## Household Projections

The total number of households in Angus is projected to change from 52,109 in 2012 to 55,098 in 2037, which is an increase of 6 per cent. In Scotland as a whole, the projected number of households is set to increase by 17 per cent over the same 25 year period.

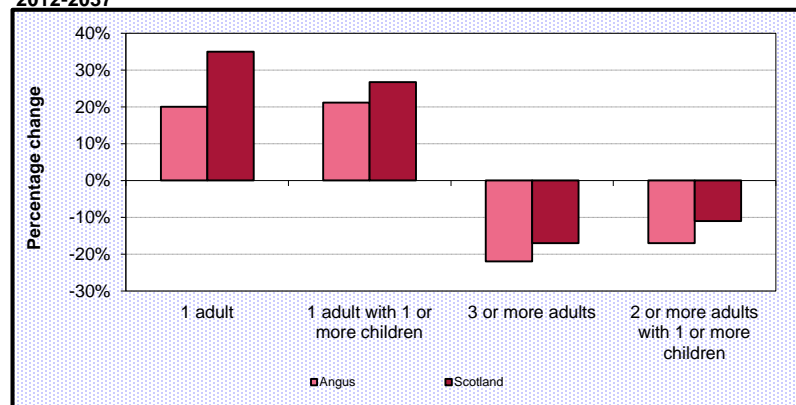
In Scotland, the number of lone adult households is projected to increase by 35 per cent over the 25 year period. In Angus, the number of lone adult households is projected to increase by 20 per cent, and the number of larger households in Angus is projected to fall, with the number of households of 2 or more adults with children decreasing by 17 per cent over the 25 year period. The average household size is projected to decrease from 2.2 in 2012 to 2.05 in 2037.

In Angus, households headed by 60-74 year olds are projected to increase in number by 2 per cent, and those headed by the 75+ age group are projected to increase in number by 81 per cent between the years 2012 and 2037.
